

## 2021 Club Championship

July 10th & 11th

## **RULES SHEET**

- Golf Canada rules govern all play unless specifically stated otherwise.
- 2. Sensitive Dune Habitats are marked as penalty areas (red or yellow stakes). For this Championship you can elect to play in these areas or proceed under the penalty area rule.
- 3. Local rules apply to all tee shots in the water on Holes 6, 7, 8, 11 and 16, where a player may choose to proceed to the drop area identified by white circles with a one stroke penalty.
- 4. For balls lost within the course boundary, but outside of a penalty area, relief may be taken from point of entry with a one stroke penalty similar to taking relief from a red-staked penalty area.
- 5. All bunkers are considered IN PLAY for this tournament. Since there are no rakes, a player has the option to take a preferred lie within one club length but the ball must remain in the bunker.
- 6. The pin must remain in the cup. The ball must rest inside the cup to be considered holed. And remember, there are no "gimmies" in tournament golf.

- 7. The overall Club Champion will be the person with the lowest aggregate gross score after play has completed. Flight winners will be determined using course handicaps.
- 8. Any ties for the Overall Championship will be a "sudden victory" playoff and will begin on the 15th Hole. All other ties will be broken by retrogression, as follows:
  - a. The winner will be determined on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, the last three holes, and finally the score on the 18th hole. If still tied, a coin toss will determine the winner.
- 9. If there are any uncertainties or disagreements regarding the rules, play a second ball according to the conflicting opinion and record the scores for both balls. All scoring decisions will be made by a committee of Crowbush and Association Executive members and will be considered final.
